

## **Xiaomi Tag**

According to Data Act, Xiaomi Tag may be classified as connected product. This document introduces what and how the data will be processed by Xiaomi Tag and potential apps.

Xiaomi Tag supports Google Find Hub and Apple Find My, and is compatible with a wide range of devices, significantly improving the accuracy of device location. To use Xiaomi Tag, users need to connect the tag to the applications like Google Find Hub or Apple Find My. In general, the majority of the data processed by Xiaomi Tag (such as the setting data) is stored on-device and Xiaomi cannot access it. In the case that users connect Xiaomi Tag to the applications such as Google Find Hub and Apple Find My, the position of Xiaomi Tag is collected by such apps directly and the data will be stored by them remotely and shown through these apps, which is not stored by Xiaomi. If our users need to access such data, please turn to the apps for help.
